

## ***e-Service and other e-filer enhancements***

### **the Arizona Court of Appeals - Division Two**

In response to attorneys' requests for the e-Filer system to automatically serve filed documents upon the opposing party, Division Two has instituted such service. All documents which the court approves for filing will be served automatically on opposing counsel of record. If no party objects, the electronic service will be deemed to have satisfied the service requirements of either ARCAP 4(b) or Ariz. R. Crim. Proc. 31.21. Any objection to e-service by a party shall be filed with the court and all parties in that case will not be served through the electronic system. **Please make sure your email address is current. Login e-filer and update your profile.**

Additionally, Division Two is instituting another feature to enhance e-filers' interaction with the court. A page on our website will be designated "My Appeals" where e-filers will see everything related to all their cases in one place. The page will show all cases they are associated with, with links provided to view the trial court record, Division Two's case record, and the docket sheet, as well as to all e-Filer functions.
